Warm Up Procedures

<u>There will be assigned lanes for WU - .</u> Use of lanes will be determined by the teams assigned to those lanes <u>"FEET FIRST ENTRY"</u> only please. Pool will be closed at 4:45am. There will be a 20 minute break after the 50 free and 5 min. break after the 500 free.

<u>Lane 1, 2</u> – Tappan Zee & Nyack Lane 3, 4 – North Rockland <u>Lane 5, 6</u> – Suffern Lane 7, 8 - Clarkstown

Entries

All eligible entry times must come from HIGH SCHOOL COMPETITIONS during the 2017-2018 season only.

Swimming Entries

- ➤ Individual See Section 1 website for entry procedures
- > Relay Entry cards are required and are to be brought to the blocks with the swimmers.
- Each <u>team</u> may enter a total of (4) contestants in each individual event and one relay team in each relay event. Athletes may participate in a maximum of either (a) two individual events and two relays or (b) one individual event and 3 relays.
- All relay cards must <u>clearly identify the lead swimmer</u>. In the absence of the aforementioned it is understood the first person listed on the entry card is the lead-off swimmer.

Diving entries

- 11 dive format (See NYS Rule Book for format NOTE:
- Divers who will be competing 11 dives will score first. Divers competing 6 dives will score after. (Ex. 5 divers doing 11 dives score 1st- 5th place, 4 divers doing 6 dives will score will place 6th 9th place. Six (6) dive contestants will use dive 101 (front dive) as the required dive.

Officials and Coaches Meeting

There will be a coach's/officials meeting on Friday, 4:45am. All meet information will be discussed at this time. NR will provide timers. However, in the event we need additional timers we are asking each team be ready to provide 1 timer.

Eligibility

The meet is open to all Section I – Rockland County Teams who are bonafide members of the National High School Federation. Entries are limited to 7-12 grade athletes. No independent athletes will be permitted to compete in this meet. **NYS Swimming and Diving Rules and Regulations** will be followed.

This is a USS Metro Sanctioned competition. All certified times will be registered in the USS SWIMS database.

Scoring

Conference - Top 16 places will score (See NYS Swimming and Diving Rules and Regulations)

Awards

Rockland County and Division IV. Champions - Medals for 1st - 3rd place finishers.

- Team plaques will be awarded to the Conference and County Champions
- MVP will be recognized and announced at the completion of the 100 Breaststroke.
- Awards for each event will be awarded at the completion of the following event (ie. Medley Relay at the end of the 200 Free, 200 free at end of 200 IM, etc.).

Team Seating

<u>Deck seating will be limited</u>. In an effort to accommodate each team (size all are encouraged to lock there belongings in a locker. Swimmers are to enter and exit the pool through the locker room. All swimmers are <u>asked</u> to keep all belongings in a locker and <u>NOT</u> on the pool deck. With the exception of coaches, officials and timers NO SHOES ARE PERMITTED ON THE POOL DECK.

It is highly recommended that no valuables be brought to the meet.
